Princess Srisavangavadhana College of Medicine, Chulabhorn Royal Academy is accepting applications for admission to the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) Program in Medical Physics and Medical Engineering (International Program) for the academic year 2023.

1. Number of Acceptance

5 students

2. Application Submission Periods

2.1 Round 1: 1 November 2022 – 31 January 2023

2.2 Round 2: 1 February 2023 – 30 April 2023

3. Qualification of Applicants

3.1 **Plan 1.1:** Holders of a master's degree or equivalent in medical physics, physics, computer science, medical engineering, biomedical engineering, computer engineering or any related fields from an institution accredited by Commission of Higher Education (CHE) or accredited by CRA Council with the cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 out of a possible 4.0 from their master's degree.

3.2 **Plan 1.2:** Holders of a bachelor's degree or equivalent in medical physics, physics, computer Science, medical engineering, biomedical engineering, computer engineering or any related fields from an institution accredited by Commission of Higher Education (CHE) or accredited by CRA Council with the cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.5 out of a possible 4.0 from their bachelor's degree.

3.3 If the applicant is not a native English speaker or did not obtain their bachelor's and/or master's degree from an international academic institution in an English-speaking country within the past five years, the applicant must submit one of the following test scores that was taken within the past two years:

3.3.1 TOEFL

3.3.1.1 Paper-based: a score of at least 500

3.3.1.2 Computer-based: a score of at least 173

3.3.1.3 Internet-based: a score of at least 64

3.3.2 IELTS: a score of at least 5.0

3.3.3 CU-TEP: a score of a least 60

3.3.4 MU GRAD TEST: a score of at least 60

3.3.5 TU-GET: a score of at least 550

3.3.6 KU-EPT: a score of at least 50

4. Application Procedures

- 4.1 Fill in and submit the online application form and upload required documents (except the recommendation letters) no later than the end of the application period. The link to the online application form is provided at https://pscm.cra.ac.th/?page_id=10734.
- 4.2 Two Recommendation letters must be signed and submitted by the recommenders directly to mpme.pscm@cra.ac.th no later than the end of the application period.
- 4.3 Submit the physical examination result using the provided form to mpme.pscm@cra.ac.th no later than the end of the application period. The link to download the physical examination form is provided at https://pscm.cra.ac.th/?page_id=10734 (section: Apply Now).

5. Required Documents

- 5.3 Statement of purpose and research interests (500 - 1,000 words)
- 5.4 Copy of all university degree certificates
- 5.5 Copy of all university degree transcripts
- 5.6 For foreign applicants: One copy of passport
- 5.7 For Thai applicants: One copy of ID card and one copy of household registration
- 5.8 One 1" x 1" photo taken not more than six months prior to the application date
- 5.9 Copy of English proficiency test score (if applicable)
- 5.10 Two Recommendation letters: These letters must be signed and submitted by the recommenders directly to mpme.pscm@cra.ac.th.

6. Selection procedure

Qualified applicants will be invited for an online psychological assessment and an interview at Princess Srisavangavadhana College of Medicine, Chulabhorn Royal Academy or online via Microsoft Teams on the following dates:

6.1 Round 1:

6.1.1 Online psychological assessment: 9 February 2023

6.1.2 Onsite or online interview: 13 February 2023

6.2 Round 2:

6.2.1 Online psychological assessment: 11 May 2023

6.2.2 Onsite or online interview: 15 May 2023

During the interview, the applicants must give a presentation on their previous research work or related experience and the research interest (not longer than 30 Minutes, in English) and will be interviewed by a panel of faculty members. The applicants can use their laptops for the presentation (a HDMI connector will be available) or send the presentation file in a PowerPoint or PDF format to mpme.pscm@cra.ac.th at least 2 days before the interview.
