Re: Application for Admission to the Doctor of Philosophy Program in Medical Physics and Medical Engineering (International Program) Academic Year 2025

Princess Srisavangavadhana College of Medicine, Chulabhorn Royal Academy is accepting applications for admission to the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) Program in Medical Physics and Medical Engineering (International Program) for the academic year 2025.

1. Number of Acceptance

5 students

2. Application Submission Periods

1st Round: From 1st November 2024 to 31th January 2025

2nd Round: From 22nd February 2025 to 18th April 2025

3. Qualification of the Applicant

An applicant admitted to this program must have graduated from a tertiary-level educational institute accredited by the Commission on Higher Education (CHE) or accredited by CRA Council in the field of medical physics, physics, computer science, medical engineering, biomedical engineering, computer engineering or any related fields and have been successfully reviewed by the appropriate selection committee as follows

- 3.1 Plan 1.1: A Holder of a master's degree or equivalent with the cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 out of a possible 4.0 from their master's degree, or a current student at a master's degree level with outstanding results.
- 3.2 Plan 1.2: A holder of a bachelor's degree or equivalent with the GPA of at least 3.5 out of a possible 4.0 from their bachelor's degree.

- 3.3 If the applicant is not a native English speaker or did not obtain their bachelor's and/or master's degree from an international academic institution in an English-speaking country within the past five years, the applicant must submit one of the following test scores that was taken within the past two years.
 - 3.3.1 TOEFL
 - 3.3.1.1 Paper-based: a score of at least 500
 - 3.3.1.2 Internet-based: a score of at least 65
 - 3.3.1.3 ITP: a score of at least 500
 - 3.3.2 TOEIC: a score at least 650
 - 3.3.3 IELTS: a score of at least 5.5
 - 3.3.4 CU-TEP: a score of a least 65
 - 3.3.5 MU GRAD TEST: a score at least 60
 - 3.3.6 MU GRAD PLUS: a score at least 70
 - 3.3.7 KU-EPT: a score of at least 50
 - 3.3.8 TU-GET: a score of at least 500 (Paper-based), 80 (Computer-based)
 - 3.3.9 CEFR: a score at least C1

4. Application Procedures

- 4.1 Complete all required information and upload the necessary documents (except the recommendation letters) no later than the end of the application period at admission system (https://mpme.cra.th)
- 4.2 Complete the online psychological test no later than the end of the application period at https://forms.office.com/r/QNGYW6UKXX.
- 4.3 Recommendation letters from two reference persons must be signed and submitted by the reference persons directly to mpme.pscm@cra.ac.th no later than the end of the application period.

5. Required Documents

- 5.1 One completed physical examination result form (Download the form from https://mpme.cra.th)
- 5.2 One completed consent form for verifying true copies of university degree certificates and transcripts (Download the form from https://mpme.cra.th)
- 5.3 One curriculum vitae (CV)
- 5.4 One statement of purpose and research interests (500 1,000 words)

- 5.5 One copy of all university degree certificates and transcripts (Please upload as a single PDF file)
- 5.6 For applicants graduated with a GPA system different from the 4.0 scale: Reliable evidence of GPA conversion to the 4.0 scale. (if applicable)
- 5.7 For Thai applicants: One copy of ID card and household registration For international applicants: One copy of passport
- 5.8 One copy of certificate of change of name (if applicable)
- 5.9 One 1" x 1" photo taken not more than six months prior to the application date
- 5.10 One copy of a valid English proficiency test score (if applicable).

6. Selection procedure

Qualified applicants will be invited for an interview at Princess Srisavangavadhana College of Medicine, Chulabhorn Royal Academy or online via Microsoft Teams on 17th February 2025 (1st round), and 28th April 2024 (2nd round). During the interview, the applicants must give a presentation on their previous research work or related experience as well as the PhD research interest of no longer than 20 minutes in English. The applicants will be interviewed by a panel of the selection committee members. The applicants can use their laptops for the presentation (a HDMI connector will be available for onsite interview), or send the presentation file in a PowerPoint or PDF format to mpme.pscm@cra.ac.th at least 2 days before the interview.

7. Announcement of Accepted Applicants

The names of accepted applicants will be announced on 21st February 2025 (1st round) and 8th May 2025 (2nd round).
